

2020—2021 Child Nutrition Meal Service FAQ

In School Meals

How will school meals be safely served in the cafeteria?

Students will be served on disposable trays. All foods available for student selection will be packaged for protected meal service.

How will I put money on my child's account?

All households are encouraged to utilize <https://www.ezschoollpay.com/> to place money on meal accounts. Cash meal money will be accepted from students at a campus assigned location and time, apart from meal service, to reduce risk of viral transmission in the presence of food.

Will my child have to punch their number in on the register pin pad?

No, the cafeteria staff will use roster mode in the POS cash register to identify and ring up students or the cashier will enter the student name or ID number. High School and Junior High students will scan their student ID and the cashier will ring up the sale.

Drive-Thru Meals

Will the school offer food for remote learners?

Yes, The Child Nutrition Department will provide drive-thru meals (breakfast and lunch) for remote learners. Both breakfast and lunch will be offered at the times listed below.

Will students (remote learners) have to be in the car to receive a drive-thru meal?

No, the student does not need to be in the car. A parent or guardian may bring the student's ID card to obtain the meal. For those students without a school issued ID card (Pre-K thru 5th grade), a Remote Learner Meal ID card can be picked up from your child's campus.

Will I have to pay for the meal offered in the Drive Thru meal line?

Meals will be available at the Paid/Reduced/Free rates depending upon individual student eligibility. Paid and Reduced certified students must have adequate funds (money) in their account to purchase a meal.

How can I put money on my child's account?

All households are encouraged to utilize <https://www.ezschoollpay.com/> to place money on meal accounts. Cash meal money will **not** be accepted in the drive-thru for the remote learners.

What food will be served in the Drive-Thru lines?

Where will the drive-thru food be served?

These meals will be distributed at the High School Campus. Signs will be posted at these campuses directing families to the pick-up location.

What campus do I go to, to obtain a meal?

Beginning Monday, August 31st, only the Junior High will be open for meal pick-up.

What will the procedure be to order the meal(s)?

Please complete the order form at the link below. This link will be open from midnight to 9:00 am each day. Meals will need to be ordered by 9:00 am each day to be ready for the drive thru.

What will the procedure be to pick-up the meal(s)?

- Vehicles will need to enter the campus according to posted signs directing to the bus drop-off and pick-up areas.
- Students &/or parents (guardians) will present their student's ID card or the Remote Learner meal ID to the cashier at the curbside delivery point.
- The cashier will scan the ID card and verify the student's pre-order of a meal (or meals).
- The cashier will ring up the meal (s).
